- GO No. 1067/78-2-2017-42-IT/2017 dated 12 May 2017 issued to make e-tendering process mandatory in all Government Departments
- Before e-tendering was made mandatory (July 2008-March 2017 i.e. 9 years duration), total tenders uploaded 45892
- After e-tendering made mandatory (April 2017 onwards), total tenders 54098

- Before e-tendering implementation, 33450 contractors had digital signatures & logged in till 30 April 2017
- After e-tendering implementation, 27704 contractors obtained digital signatures and logged in on UP e-tender portal after 1 May 2017
- 1842 Government Officers have obtained digital signatures & registered on e-tender portal

- 641 Master Trainers/Nodal Officers trained across 50+ Departments/ Corporations / Agencies etc
- 43 Organizations have published e-tenders since 1 May 2017
- 40 New Organizations are ready to publish e-tenders

- PWD, Irrigation, Minor Irrigation & Rural Engineering Departments have been carrying out e-tendering since last 3-5 years. Their expertise can be used by other departments at district level
- Trainings conducted at 18 districts
- e-tendering cells formed at 10 districts
- Tendering unit identified at 21 districts

- Master Trainers appointed at Mandal HQ
- Master Trainers appointed at 19 districts. Remaining appointments are under process
